

MEMO TO: ALL STAFF, CONTRACT WORKERS, MEDICAL STAFF
SUBJECT: COVID-19 TESTING
DATE: MAY 14, 2020

In accordance with Executive Order 202.30. and ACF DAL #20-14, NH-20-07, dated May 10, 2020, Acadia Center for Nursing + Rehabilitation is required to begin testing for all Acadia Center Personnel, Contract Workers, Medical Staff, Operators, and Administrators.

Testing will commence the week of May 17th until June 9TH, 2020.
Testing days and times have been divided into two groups:
Mondays & Thursdays and Tuesdays & Fridays.
6am – 9am and 2pm – 4pm

At that time, all personnel, contract workers and medical staff are required to report to the lobby for a medical assessment prior to clocking in. The COVID-19 testing process will be incorporated in this assessment. All staff shall be tested twice a week unless the test results in a positive outcome.

Any personnel who test positive for COVID-19 must remain at home in isolation, personnel who test positive for COVID-19 but remain asymptomatic are not eligible to return to work for 14 days from the date of the first positive test.

Symptomatic nursing home personnel may not return to work until 14 days after the onset of symptoms, provided at least three days (72 hours) have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and respiratory symptoms are improving.

Acadia Center may accept documentation of testing conducted by an individual's healthcare provider in lieu of being tested. You can also go to the Stonybrook drive-through for free testing.

Should staff refuse to be tested, they will be informed that they are non-compliant with directive and therefore are not able to work. The personnel will be given a three-day period to decide to be tested or will be terminated.
